The NSW government wants to demolish Waterloo estate's existing social housing to make way for 7,500 homes for more than 14,000 residents in buildings that will climb to 40 storeys. To make matters worse, Waterloo is adjacent to Zetland and The Australian Technology Park that will house 20,000 extra workers in the area.

We need a planning system for our neighbourhood that puts people and communities back at the heart of the planning system -- not commercial interests.
